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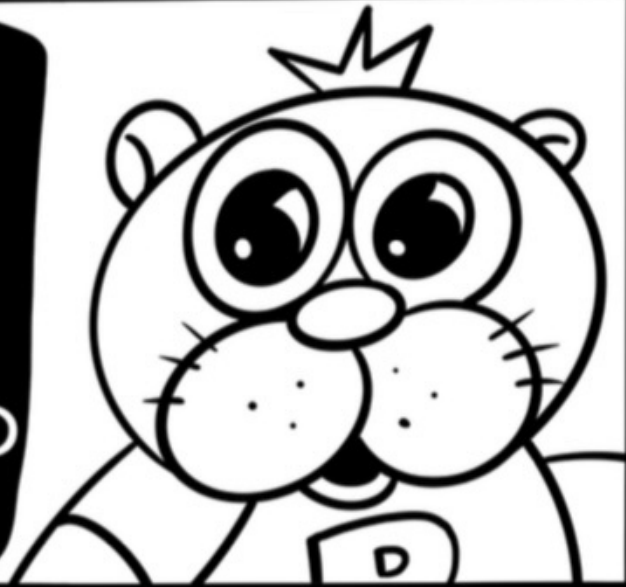

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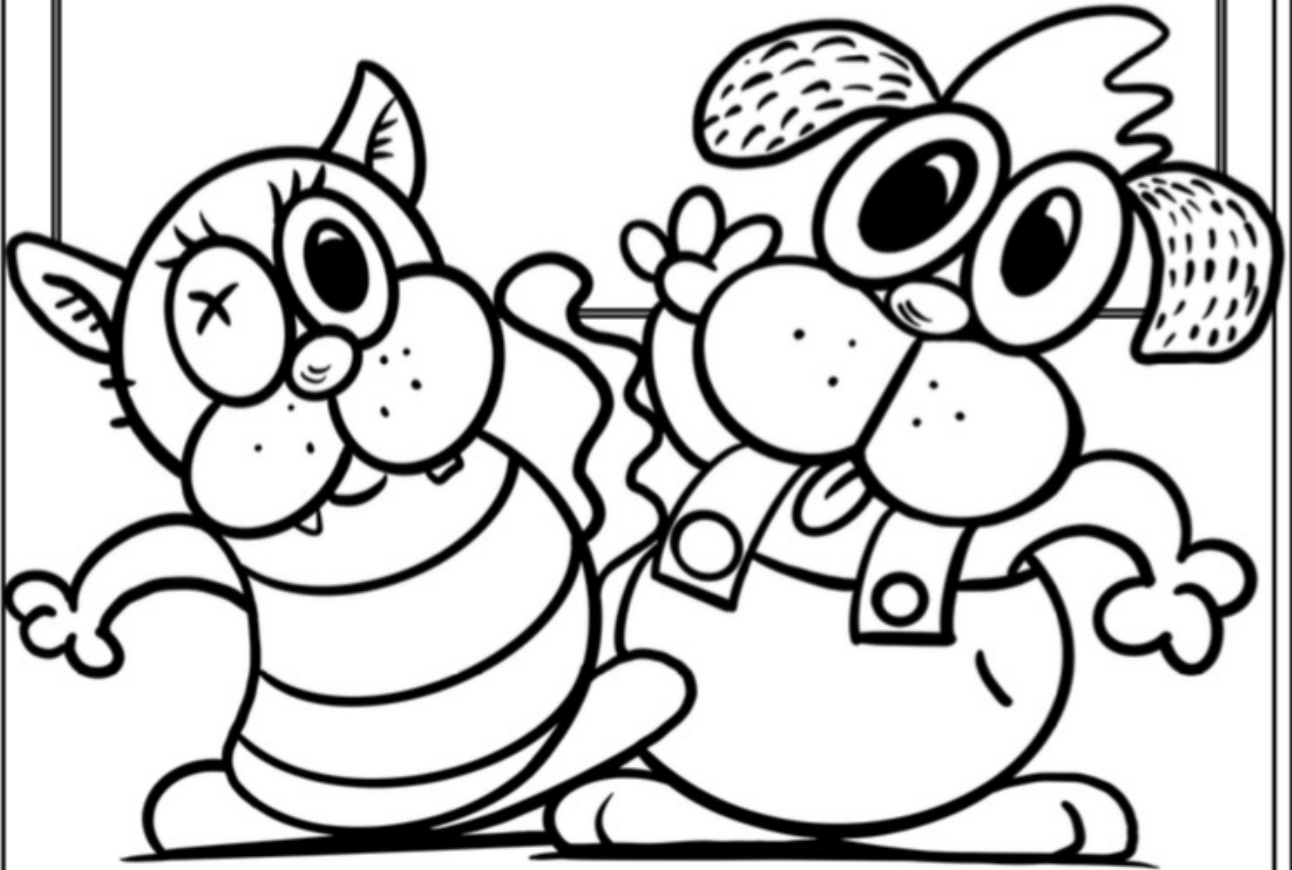

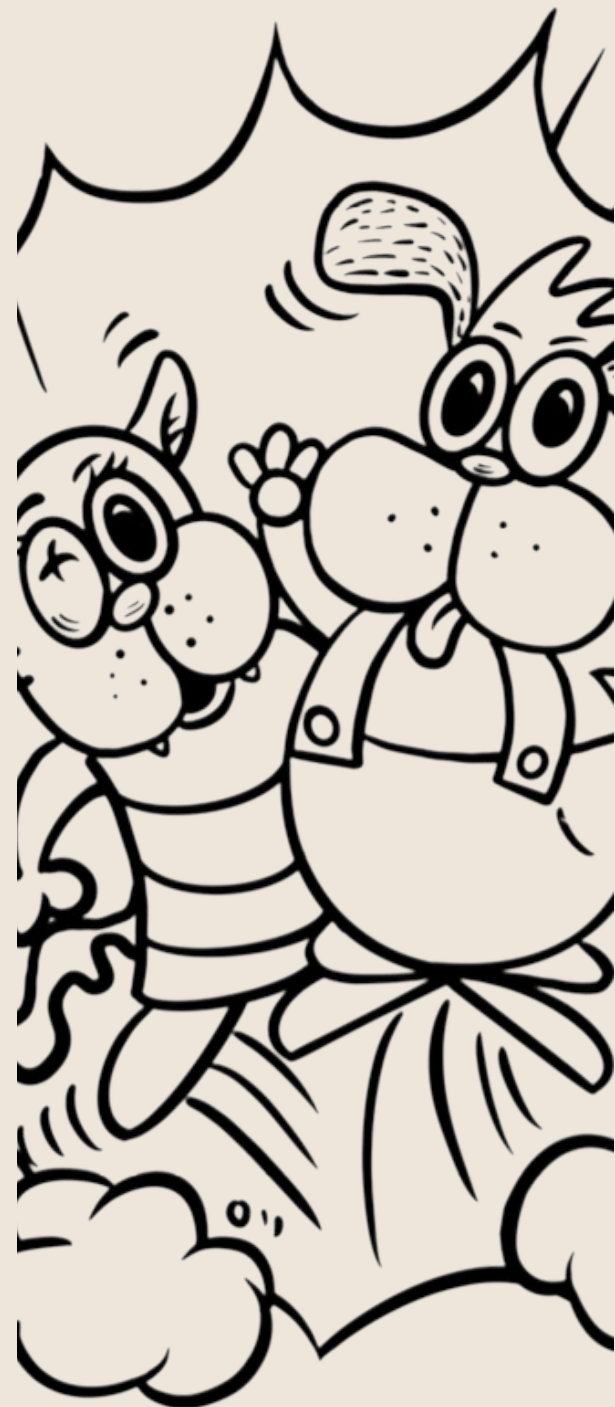
"Children have the right to food, clothing and a safe place to live so they can develop in the best possible way." UNICEF -The Convention on the Rights of the Child.

True to our mission, the sister organization, Trisha Ambara was created in Indonesia. The "Kids Protect Project" is considered to be one of this organization's first major activities.



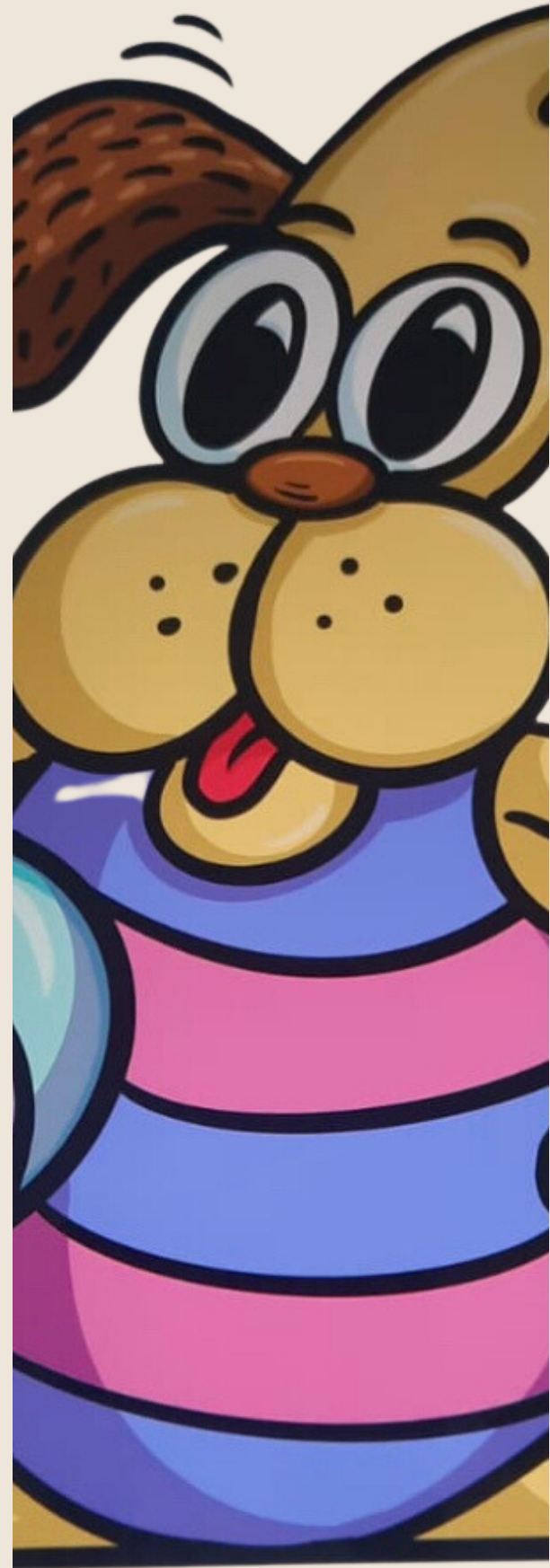
ENDORSEMENT AND REVIEW

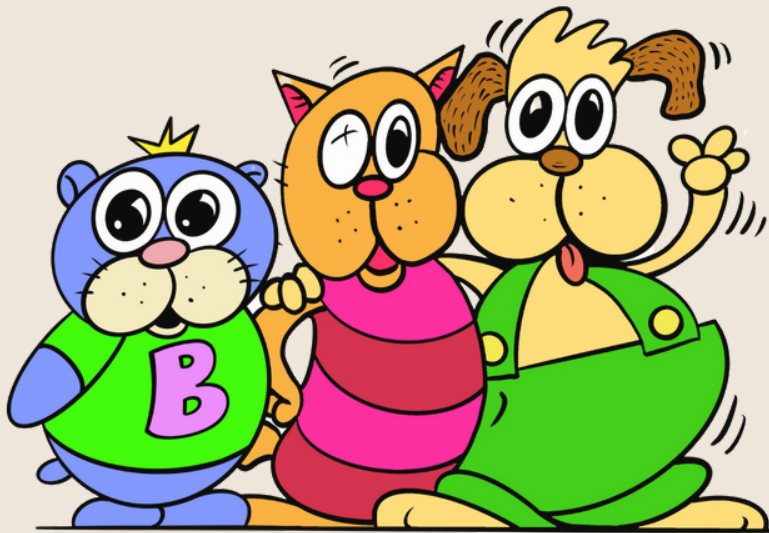
